The Page County Board of Supervisors met for business and budget work with all members present. The Board reviewed the budgets of Veterans Affairs, Emergency Management, and E911 with Rod Riley. CPC Jane Miller explained the Mental Health and General Assistance budgets.

CPC Miller presented the Iowa DHS Community Mental Health Center Affiliation for the Chairman to sign. She presented a Business Associate Agreement with Alegent Health for the Chairman to sign. On a motion by Richardson, seconded by Herzberg, the Chairman was unanimously authorized to sign the two documents. Miller presented sealed bids for office carpet from five vendors, which Chairman Armstrong opened: Sheridan Decorating -\$2280.72; The Carpet Store-\$2210.48; J&R Furniture-\$2837.44; Bopp's-\$2787.08; and Shenandoah Home Furnishings-\$2590.00. On a motion by Herzberg, seconded by Richardson, the Board unanimously approved the low bid from The Carpet Store. Miller will contact The Carpet Store.

The Page County Board of Supervisors met in session on this 9th day of February with all members present. The minutes of February 8 were approved unanimously.

County Engineer Brad Skinner met with the Board to open sealed bids for re-letting EWP Project 7315-02 in 29/30 Washington Township, without the rock or steel materials (already on hand). Bids received were: Empire Construction-\$205,411.00; L. A. Carlson-\$215,465.50; Nelson & Rock-\$321,773.50; Peterson Construction (PCI)-\$274,315.80. The Board will make a decision next Tuesday after a review of the bids and calculations by the County Engineer.

The Recorder's Reports of Fees for December and January were received and filed.

The Board spoke with the Fremont County Board of Supervisors regarding levying for Johnson Run. Both Boards agreed to continue levying this next year, and official action will be taken next Tuesday.
