AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE COUNTY SUPERVISOR DISTRICTS AND
ELECTION PRECINCTS

Be it Enacted by the Board of Supervisors of Page County, Iowa:

SECTION 1: PURPOSE. The purpose of this ordinance is to establish County Supervisor districts and election precincts as the result of the population changes reflected by the 2000 Census, in accordance with Iowa Code Sections 49.7 and 331.210A.

SECTION 2. LEGAL DESCRIPTION OF DISTRICTS:

District #1—Population 5,640 shall encompass the following:

Amity, Buchanan, Colfax, Douglas, East River, Fremont, Grant (Sections 1-18, 22-27, and 31 (remainder)-36, Harlan, Lincoln, Morton, Nebraska, Nodaway, Pierce, Tarkio, Valley and Washington Townships and the cities of Blanchard, Braddyville, Coin, College Springs, Essex, Hepburn, Northboro, Shambaugh and Yorktown.

District #2—Population 5,646 shall encompass the following:

City of Shenandoah

Grant Township—that portion which is totally surrounded by the City of Shenandoah (census block 2040), and Grant Township remainder of sections 20, 29 and 30, and Sections 21 and 28, and a small portion of section 31 (census blocks 2037 and 2038) (census blocks 2036, 2037, 2038, 3000, 3011, 3019, 3032, 3029, 4108 and 4109

District #3—Population 5,690 shall encompass the following:

City of Clarinda

SECTION 4. LEGAL DESCRIPTION OF PRECINCTS:

All voting precincts (except Clarinda Precincts and Shenandoah Precincts established by the Clarinda and Shenandoah City Councils) shall be designated as follows:

1. Amity Precinct (AM) shall include all of the cities of Braddyville, College Springs, Shambaugh and all of the remainder of Amity, Buchanan and Harlan Townships.
2. Colfax Precinct (CX) shall include all of the cities of Blanchard, Coin, and Northboro and all the remainder of Colfax, Lincoln and Washington Townships.
3. East River Precinct (ER) shall include all of the cities of Hepburn and Yorktown and all the remainder of East River, Nebraska, and Valley Townships and all of Nodaway Township outside the city limits of Clarinda.
4. Fremont Precinct (FM) shall include all of Douglas and Fremont Townships.
5. Grant Precinct (GT) shall include all of the remainder of Grant Township outside the city limits of Shenandoah and EXCEPT that portion surrounded by the City of Shenandoah which shall be included in Shenandoah Ward 2 (census block 2040), and all of Morton and Tarkio Townships.
6. Pierce Precinct (PC) shall include all of the city of Essex and all of the remainder of Pierce Township.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE: This ordinance shall become effective after its passage and publication as provided by law.

August 13, 2001**

Proposed Plan for County Supervisor Districts

District #1—Population 5640

Amity, Buchanan, Colfax, Douglas, East River, Fremont, Grant (Sections 1-18, 22-27, and 31 (remainder)-36, Harlan, Lincoln, Morton, Nebraska, Nodaway, Pierce, Tarkio, Valley and Washington Townships and the cities of Blanchard, Braddyville, Coin, College Springs, Essex, Hepburn, Northboro, Shambaugh and Yorktown.

District #2—Population 5646

City of Shenandoah

Grant Township—that portion which is totally surrounded by the City of Shenandoah (census block 2040), and Grant Township remainder of sections 20, 29 and 30, and Sections 21 and 28, and a small portion of section 31 (census blocks 2037 and 2038) (census blocks 2036, 2037, 2038, 3000, 3011, 3019, 3032, 3029, 4108 and 4109

District #3—Population 5690

City of Clarinda

The Page County Temporary Redistricting Commission held a public hearing at 10:00 a.m. in the Page County Board room. The notice of public hearing was published in all three official County newspapers. The Commission (Corrine Williams, Jim Richardson, and Judy Clark), the Page County Supervisors and Kent Dinnebier, the Clarinda Herald Journal editor, were the only people in attendance.

The Commission presented their plan. At 10:10 a.m. the public hearing was closed. On a motion by Corinne Williams and seconded by Jim Richardson, the Commission unanimously adopted the plan as proposed.

The Commission then presented the plan to the Page County Board of Supervisors. After review, the Board unanimously accepted the plan as presented.

9. East River Precinct (ER) shall include all of the cities of Hepburn and Yorktown and all the remainder of East River, Nebraska, and Valley Townships and all of Nodaway Township outside the city limits of Clarinda.
10. Fremont Precinct (FM) shall include all of Douglas and Fremont Townships.
11. Grant Precinct (GT) shall include all of the remainder of Grant Township outside the city limits of Shenandoah, and all of Morton and Tarkio Townships.
12. Pierce Precinct (PC) shall include all of the city of Essex and all of the remainder of Pierce Township.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE: This ordinance shall become effective after its passage and publication as provided by law.

3. East River Precinct (ER) shall include all of the cities of Hepburn and Yorktown and all the remainder of East River, Nebraska, and Valley Townships and all of Nodaway Township outside the city limits of Clarinda.
4. Fremont Precinct (FM) shall include all of Douglas and Fremont Townships.
5. Grant Precinct (GT) shall include all of the remainder of Grant Township outside the city limits of Shenandoah and EXCEPT that portion surrounded by the City of Shenandoah which shall be included in Shenandoah Ward 2 (census block 2040), and all of Morton and Tarkio Townships.
6. Pierce Precinct (PC) shall include all of the city of Essex and all of the remainder of Pierce Township.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE: This ordinance shall become effective after its passage and publication as provided by law.
