The following programs use the Federal Health & Human Services Guidelines or multiples of them:

- 100% - Head Start; Early Head Start
- 130% - Shared Visions; National School Lunch Program (Free - at or below 130%); Medicaid (133%)
- 145% - Child Care Subsidy
- 150% - Low Income Energy Assistance (LIHEAP); Weatherization
- 185% - WIC; Title V - Maternal & Child Health Services; National School Lunch Program (Reduced fees - between 130% - 185%)
- 200% - ECI Low-Income Preschool Tuition Assistance; *hawk-I*

Proof of family income may include one or more of the following:

- Copy of Federal tax return from previous year
- Approved* Free and Reduced Lunch waiver
- 2 months of current pay stubs
- Current FIP Notice of Decision letter
